All student, advisor, student registrations must be in the online conference registration system by **12/3/25**. This event does not allow late registrations. Each chapter must have at least one advisor registered, and this advisor is responsible for supervising students during the regional conference. A chapter advisor is responsible for all student competitive event assignments and ensuring students are aware of all competition schedules posted in the registration system.

**Registration fees are not refundable for any reason. Payment is due no later than December 13,2025 . Failure to pay by this date will result in disqualification.**

**Registration notes:** Registration includes a regional pin and lunch. Seating for the awards ceremony is as follows; student competitors, advisors, registered judges and badged guests will be seated first. Any parent without a badge will be asked to wait until all badged participants are seated. If there are seats left, then parents will be allowed in. **Please communicate this with your parents.**

Students may compete in multiple competitions as long as there are not time conflicts. Conflicts should be worked out with each competition coordinator. Note: The on-site TEAMS event will take four hours. Students are not allowed to leave this event and return. Please plan accordingly.

Competitive events will only run during the posted schedule so a student will need to make choice if competitions overlap

Medals will be presented to each 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners in each competitive event category during the Manatee West Coast Regional Award Ceremony.

## Dress Code

Participants should wear the official TSA attire. Failure to wear the official attire will result in the student not being allowed to compete.

Chapter Team participants may wear the full competition attire.

### **Additional Information**

- There will be no protests or grievances accepted in the Manatee West Coast Regionals. Any disputes that arise during a competition will be resolved onsite with judges and coordinators during the competition. Coordinators and judges may consult FL TSA Executive Director for advice before issuing a final ruling.

- Any advisors, students, or parents who violate the FL TSA code of conduct shall be suspended from the conference and removed from the property. A violation may require further disciplinary review with Florida TSA.
- Member chapters are responsible for registering their chaperones and verifying they are approved to participate in school functions.
- School employees of any district must bring their school ID for entrance
- Judges must arrive no later than 30 minutes prior to their judging assignment.
