All students must be in the online conference registration system by the posted deadline. This event does not allow late registrations. Each chapter must have at least one advisor registered and this advisor is responsible for supervising students during the regional conference. A chapter advisor is responsible for all student competitive event assignments and ensuring students are aware of all competition schedules posted in the registration system.

Registration fees are not refundable for any reason.

Students may compete in multiple competitions as long as there are not time conflicts. Competitive events will only run during the posted schedule so a student will need to make choice if competitions overlap. Volunteer coordinators and judges will not be asked to stay past programmed times.

Awards will be presented for $1^{st} - 3^{rd}$ place winners in each competitive event category during the Gold Coast Regional Conference Awards ceremony. Awards are projected to be presented on Thursday, February 5^{th} on Zoom at 7pm.

One conference package will be sent to each school after the competition. This package will include award medals and conference pins. Please make sure the school address in the conference system is correct since packages will be addressed using that information with attention to the registered chapter advisor.

Project Submissions

Online Project Submissions will open on January 31st and close on February 2nd at 11:59pm. Only entries that are submitted will be judged and eligible for placement.

Additional Information

- There will be no protests or grievances accepted in the Gold Coast Regional Competition.
- Any issues not associated with judging will be reviewed and resolved by FL TSA Executive Director who will make a final ruling.
- Any advisors, students, or parents who violate the FL TSA code of conduct shall be suspended from the conference and removed from the property. A violation may require further disciplinary review with Florida TSA.
- There is no guest registration with this event since it is a virtual conference. This conference services schools in the Gold Coast Area of Florida (Broward, Miami-Dade, and Palm Beach counties). Schools outside of this area may inquire to see if capacity is available to accept a school from an area that does not have a regional conference.
